

Society to Read Stoddard Letters

Historical Unit to Meet Thursday in Bladensburg.

Correspondence of Benjamin Stoddard, first Secretary of the Navy, will be read before the Bladensburg Historical Society next Thursday, it was announced yesterday.

The letters will be read by Brice Clagett who will also tell something of Stoddard's life at the famous Bostwick House, Bladensburg. Stoddard married into the family of Benjamin Lowndes, well-known Bladensburg shipping merchant.

Mrs. Virginia T. Fell will talk on the Carroll family, who were prominently associated with the famous Addison Chapel, Seat Pleasant, Md. Frank Fierstein will tell of the noted families buried in Evergreen Cemetery, Bladensburg.
